Deaf Can:Do Community and Leadership Scholarships are provided by the Can:Do Group to groups and individuals. They are available for projects that support the growth and development of leadership for those who are Deaf or hard of hearing, with a focus on young and emerging leaders within the Deaf community of South Australia.

In order to apply, you must cover this information in a video:

- What do you want to use the scholarship for?**
(for example: to go to an event, to start a project, to give or go to training)
- How will this benefit your development?**
(for example: you will learn a new skill, meet new people, learn from experts)
- How will this help the South Australian Deaf Community?**
(for example: better resources, a new project, more connected community)
- How will you know if you have been successful?**
(for example: you will make new connections, you will make a report)
- How you will show your success to Deaf Can:Do?**
(for example: a presentation on your finished project, a video, photographs)
- How much money you will ask for, and what the main expenses will be?**
(for example, equipment, tickets to an event, flights, accommodation)
- How long will your project take? A few months, 1 year, over 1 year?**

Community Leadership Scholarship Terms and Conditions

This document outlines the Terms and Conditions for scholarships administered by the Can:Do Group on behalf of Deaf Can:Do, The Royal South Australian Deaf Society and Can:Do 4Kids, Townsend House. All scholarships will be referred to as 'scholarships' herein.

You must read these Terms and Conditions in full. In accepting a scholarship from the Can:Do Group, it is understood that you have read and agree to comply with these Terms and Conditions.

Please note, if you are under 18 years of age, your parent or guardian must read and consent to these Terms and Conditions on your behalf.

Successful scholarship applicants will receive a letter of offer which details the scholarship benefits and payment timing. If you do not wish to accept a scholarship you are offered, you should advise us immediately in writing.

By submitting this scholarship application you confirm your understanding of the following conditions;

- you understand that you cannot claim against Can:Do Group for any damage or injury incurred as a result of this project.
- you understand that the Can:Do Group reserves the right to withdraw the scholarship and their support at any time should the project or applicant fail to comply with Can:Do Group guidelines.
- you understand that the Can:Do Group, its staff and volunteers cannot be held responsible for any loss or damage that occurs
- as a direct or indirect result of this project.
- you confirm that you are in a suitable physical and mental condition to undertake the project and have considered and taken measures to mitigate any risk that may be associated with the project.

Upon acceptance of a scholarship offer from the Can:Do Group you agree to;

- make every effort to uphold the good name and character of the Can:Do Group;
- acknowledge the support of the Can:Do Group, including any reference to Deaf Can:Do, The Royal South Australian Deaf Society and Can:Do 4Kids, Townsend House in a positive light;

- not claim, or imply, that you speak on behalf of the Can:Do Group or that your views are representative of the Can:Do Group
- seek the authorisation of the Can:Do Group before using our brands or logos in any form
- not undertake any activities that are unlawful
- conduct your project in accordance with these guidelines
- act in good faith with the Can:Do Group

The Can:Do Group may terminate your scholarship if we deem that you have;

- represented any part of the Can:Do Group, including Deaf Can:Do, The Royal South Australian Deaf Society and Can:Do 4Kids,
- Townsend House in a negative or misleading way;
- failed to meet the eligibility requirements of your scholarship;
- failed to meet the scholarships terms and conditions;
- failed to undertake the project outlined in your application to a level deemed satisfactory by the Can:Do Group;
- failed to undertake the project outlined in your application within the agreed timeframe;
- been made an incorrect scholarship offer as determined by the Can:Do Group at its sole discretion; and/or
- have provided incorrect, false or misleading information or withheld relevant information on your scholarship application or
- after receiving a scholarship offer.

If your scholarship is terminated, you will not receive any further payments. You may be required to repay some or all of your scholarship.

Terms and Conditions (Cont.)

At the end of the project duration specified in your scholarship application you will be asked to provide a report detailing how the scholarship funds have been spent. It is the responsibility of the scholarship recipient to provide this report to the Can:Do Group by the specified me. Failure to return reports by the specified me may result in a request for return of the funds provided.

You will also need to repay the scholarship if:

- the payment is made to you in error or you have been overpaid;
- your scholarship is terminated;
- you do not meet the conditions of the scholarship or are deemed to be ineligible for the scholarship;

In the event that you are required to repay your scholarship, you must do so within 4 weeks of receiving the notification.

If you are offered a scholarship, your details including name, project, photograph, video and scholarship awarded may be passed on to media and used by the Can:Do Group and / or partner organisations for promotional purposes, including but not limited to the Can:Do Group's website, social media channels, print and electronic media. If you do not wish for your details to be passed on to media or used for promotional purposes, you must notify the Can:Do Group in writng.

If you attend events held by the Can:Do Group, photos and videos of you at the event (along with your name and scholarship), may be used for promotional purposes by the Can:Do Group and / or our partner organisations, including but not limited to the Can:Do Group website, social media channels, print and electronic media.

It is agreed that the use of these photographs and videos shall in no way be used in any other forum other than official Can:Do Group business. The scholarship recipient also waives the right to inspect or approve the finished product, the advertising copy or other matter that may be used in connection therewith or the use to which is may be applied. If you do not wish for photographs and videos of you to be used in this way, you must notify the Can:Do Group in writing.

All correspondence during the application process will be sent to the applicant's address or primary email address submitted in the scholarship application form.

It is the responsibility of the scholarship recipient to inform the Can:Do Group of any changes to their email, postal or residential address.

Please note, if you are under 18 years of age, it is understood that your parent or guardian has read and agreed to the Scholarship Terms and Conditions on your behalf.

The Can:Do Group reserves the right to amend these Terms and Conditions for commencing and continuing scholarship holders.
